About this level

Level 1 will suit you if you are just starting out and want to gain the basic knowledge and skills needed to move on to further study or get an entry-level job working in the land based occupations, such as forestry, gardening, landscaping or agriculture.

It is also useful if you enjoy practical work and construction and want to develop your practical skills with handtools and learn more about the countryside and traditional crafts.
